9.00pm		Get ready for bed
9.30pm		Lights out (this will be earlier for younger children)

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN RESIDENTIAL AND NON-RESIDENTIAL HOLIDAYS?

RESIDENTIAL HOLIDAYS

Children booked for a residential holiday arrive on the Sunday afternoon after 3pm and depart on the following Saturday before 11am.

The holiday is inclusive of all meals, evening activities, and the children are fully supervised at all times. The children sleep on site in cabins. Our accommodation is basic but totally suitable for this type of outdoor activity holiday.



NON-RESIDENTIAL

On a non-residential holiday, the children do not stay on site with us, but travel in and out on a 9am-5pm basis.

This is suitable for children who live locally, or if parents and children are staying at a local B & B. Lunch is included in the non-residential package, as are all the riding activities that the Residential children take part in.
