



# RIDING

## Covid-19 Guidelines, what to expect when you compete at Wellington Riding

- Entries can be made on-line, in advance only.
- Drawn orders and times will be allocated for all classes; competitors will also be provided with a warm-up time. Times will be published on our website by close of play the day before the show <https://wellington-riding.co.uk/events/times/>
- We will need to capture the details of everyone accompanying each rider to our shows to comply with the government's Track & Trace protocols. If you did not complete these details when you made your entries online **please email the names of all those attending to [ridingshows@wellington.co.uk](mailto:ridingshows@wellington.co.uk)**. This will help to speed up your arrival process.
- Senior athletes can be accompanied by one other person, with one additional person for every additional horse entered. Junior athletes (18 and under) are now limited to two adults per member, with one additional person allowed for any additional horse/pony entered.
- On arrival, you will be met at the entrance to the lorry park where an official will check off the names of all those accompanying you. We reserve the right to refuse entry to those who are not on the list. No spectators are allowed on site. All shows will operate behind closed doors.
- Please wear a face mask when at the secretary's office or on the first floor of the clubhouse (unless you are seated in the café areas). Show jumping/arena eventing competitors must wear a face mask when course walking. Please do not touch any equipment unless wearing gloves.
- For all competitions there will be 2 warm up arenas:
  - Show jumping – one flat and one jump.
  - Dressage – two flat incorporating the Waterloo Arenas and Duke's Hall.
  - Please follow the horse walk from the lorry park, round the back of the Duke's Hall to the Waterloo Arena entrance. You will be welcomed by one of our stewards who will direct you to the correct warm-up and who will call you forward when there is space for you. Please arrive on time to the warm-up. Riders who do not present themselves at the warm-up on time may not be able to compete. There is a maximum

- number of riders allowed in each warm-up arena: 6 for show jumping, 7 for dressage.
- For show jumping only - you will be asked by the steward to progress from the flat warm-up to the jump warm-up. An official will be available in the jump warm-up to alter fences.
  - No additional helpers are allowed in the warm-ups.
- Please enter the competition arena at the far end. When your round/test is finished, we ask that you leave the arena as promptly as possible by the exit nearest the clubhouse.
  - Please return to the lorry park via the horse walk as soon as your round/test is finished.
  - Those accompanying you may spectate from designated areas (the seats next to the warm-up area or the bank beside the competition arena), but please maintain social distancing at all times. Please do not gather in the area outside the entrance to the Duke's Hall which is designated for use by the Riding School.
  - Spectators not on the list of those accompanying a rider are not allowed anywhere on site.
  - Results will not be posted on the notice board. We will post placings on our Facebook page after each class and the full results will be available on our website at the end of the day. <https://wellington-riding.co.uk/events/results/>
  - If you have won prize money, we will contact you by email to obtain your bank details (sort code, account number and account name) and payment will be made by bank transfer.
  - There is a one-way system in the café, please observe the signs. If you wish to eat in the café you will be asked for your contact details for Track & Trace purposes. The galleries are part of the café and will be treated in the same way. No spectating from the galleries unless using the café. Take-away is also available.
  - The kitchen closes at 4pm and the Café closes at 5pm.
  - Please use the exit at the rear of the property onto the B3349 and not the main driveway.
